Free of charge – no appointment necessary – counselling included For all German residents over 16 years of age

Which vaccines are being used?

All available vaccines

What do I need to bring to get vaccinated?

Valid identification document Vaccination passport (if you have one)

Are second doses also available?

Yes. The minimum waiting period since the first dose must be kept:

- BioNTech 3 weeks
- Moderna 4 weeks
- AstraZeneca mixed doses (first dose using AstraZeneca second dose using BioNTech or Moderna) 4 weeks
- Vaccination with the Johnson & Johnson vaccine requires a single dose only
- You must bring proof of your first vaccination dose (yellow vaccination passport or vaccination certificate) when you come to receive your second dose

How do I register for vaccination?

For smooth processing at vaccination sites, it is helpful if you register on <u>impfzentren.bayern</u> ahead of time. However, you can also register directly at the vaccination site.

After you have been vaccinated, you will receive a vaccination certificate with a QR-code for the digital vaccination passport.
